

## **ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS FOR EECE SCHOLARSHIPS**

(Availability of a scholarship in a specific year depends on the funds being made available by the donor and on the interest earned by the endowment)

### **1. DANIEL G. EGAN GRANT 2 at \$1500 per year**

- fourth year senior student
- attended UL previous three years
- achieved highest GPA

### **2. HIRAM RUSSELL MASON MEMORIAL 2 at \$1000 per year**

- junior, senior, graduate student preferred, but freshman & sophomore eligible
- U.S. Citizen and a Louisiana or Texas resident
- Undergraduate GPA 3.0, grad GPA 3.3

### **3. IEEE/FELIX BOUDREAUX ENDOWED 1 at \$200 per year**

- freshman in Electrical Engineering
- ACT of 26 or greater
- high school average of B or above
- resident of "greater Acadiana"

### **4. PUGH FAMILY FOUNDATION 8 at \$1000 per year**

- junior, senior, graduate student, EECE major
- priority given to U.S. Citizen – non-citizens eligible
- Minimum GPA 3.0

### **5. INSTRUMENT SOCIETY OF AMERICA 1 at \$1500 per year**

- junior or senior in Computer Engineering Option
- overall GPA of 3.0, Minimum of 12 semester hours

### **6. Mac Hays/ TECHE Electric Supply Endowed Schp.; 1 at \$500.00/yr**

- US Citizen, LA resident
- 3.0 GPA
- LA High School Graduate

### **7. Dr. FELIX J. BOUDREAUX ENDOWED EECE SCHOLARSHIP: 1 AT \$400/YR**

- Must be a Louisiana resident, & a LA high school graduate
- Junior or senior
- Minimum 3.0 GPA

### **8. SENIOR ACHIEVEMENT ENDOWED: 1 at \$500 per year**

- senior in Electrical Engineering (graduating during academic year)
- minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0
- rank no lower than third in cumulative GPA

### **9. CLECO/MARK SEGURA MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP: 2 AT \$500/YR**

- US citizen
- Louisiana resident
- Junior or senior with a minimum of 3.0 GPA

### **10. HAROLD J. CALLAIS MEMORIAL ENDOWED SCHOLARSHIP: 2 AT \$1000/YR**

- Freshman, Sophomore, junior or senior
- US Citizen & LA Residents only
- Minimum 3.0 GPA or 28+ ACT composite
- Be a graduate of a LA High School

### **11. DR. BURKE HUNER ENDOWED ENGR LEADERSHIP SCHP: 1 AT \$400/YR**

- Preference given to IEEE elected President
- 2.8 minimum cumulative GPA
- Proven leadership abilities

### **Outstanding Graduate Award:**

Each **semester** the department selects the best graduate of the department, from amongst all of the EECE graduating students. The selection is based on GPA and other activities such as academic performance, service to department, university and the community. The selected student receives a departmental and college certificate. In addition, they also compete for the best “graduating student award” of the college and then for the university. Best graduating students of the college and university are recognized at the commencement ceremonies.
